Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage lifting capability. Hook type fork carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is more or less thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines could be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades may differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
